Training materials for teachers

The **FICTUP** project - <http://fictup.inpl-nancy.fr> - funded with the support of the Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Union, aims at:

- creating innovative training materials describing concrete pedagogical activities using ICT
- experimenting a close tutoring process among expert and novice teachers
- providing training institutions with some recommendations based on the experimentations.



The **FICTUP training materials for teachers** describe concrete pedagogical activities including ICT usage and are composed of one case for each activity. Each pedagogical scenario illustrates in detail the thematic, objectives, pupils' outputs, materials used (software, working sheets to be filled by pupils, etc.), the different pedagogical steps, for each of them the role of the teacher and the pupils' tasks, etc. Besides, each case is associated with three pedagogical short videos (ca. 2-3 minutes each) which outline specific aspects of the pedagogical activity. This training material has been developed

collaboratively by expert teachers and novice ones to ensure its accessibility. All outcomes are available online under [http://fictup.inpl-nancy.fr/index.php/Pedagogical scenarios](http://fictup.inpl-nancy.fr/index.php/Pedagogical_scenarios).

Starting by March 2010, the training materials are tested in real conditions by a novice teacher, who will implement the pedagogical activities in class, supported by a close **tutoring process** with the expert teacher. The whole phase is observed (with filming), analysed and evaluated by researchers. The final objective is then to use the experience of this project to adapt and improve the experimented training methodology (organisation of the tutoring, terms of reference for the pedagogical materials, etc.) and to propose these **transfer guidelines** for further exploitation by educational institutions.
